Gwybodaeth Gefndirod / Background Information

Mae Cynllun Celf Plas Heli yn gynllun sydd wedi ei ddatblygu gan Jessica Lloyd-Jones ac Ant Dickinson, artistiaid o Ogledd Cymru. Bydd yn ardangos golau parhaol sydd yn newid ei liw a'i ddisgleirdeb gan ymateb i gryfder y gwynt a'i gyfeiriad o fewn adeilad yr Academi Hwylio Genedlaethol a Chanolfan Ddigwyddiadau, Pwllheli

Cafodd y artistiaid eu hysbrydoli gan yliwiau a ddefnyddir yng Ngraddfa Beaufort - y system a ddefnyddir i fesur cryfder y gwynt ac sydd yn hanfodol i hwylwyr ar draws y byd - a bydd y dyluniad yn amlygu dyluniad unigryw adeilad Plas Heli.

Mae'r cynllun wedi ei ddylunio o oleuadau ynni isel (LED) ym mhrit neuaddadeilad yr Academi Hwylio Gyda mesurydd gwynt wedi eisodar do'r adeilad.

Bydd y digwyddiad lansio hefyd yn gyfle i'r sawl fydd yn mynch i weld tafluniad arbennig yn cynnwys lluniau o hanes morwrol Pwllheli o'r gorffennol a'r presennol, wedi eu cyfrannu gan aelodau'r gymuned. Mae'r gwaith celf drawiadol hwn wedi ei ariannu gan Gyngor Celfyddydau Cymru ac mae'n ychwanegu gwerth i'r cynllun Academi Hwylio Genedlaethol a Chanolfan Ddigwyddiadau Pwllheli, cynllun £8.9 miliwn wedi ei ariannu gan Gronfa Datblygu Rhanbarthol Ewrop drwy Lywodraeth Cymru a Chyngor Gwynedd.



The Plas Heli Art Project is the work of north Wales-based artists Jessica Lloyd-Jones and Ant Dickinson and will permanently illuminate the new National Sailing Academy and Events Centre, with the lights changing colour and brightness in reaction to wind strength and direction.

The artists have taken inspiration from the colours used in the Beaufort Scale – the system used to measure wind strength and is essential for sailors the world over – and the installation will highlight the distinctive architectural design of Plas Heli.

The artwork has been made possible by energy efficient LED illumination on the main hall of the Sailing Academy and wind meters mounted on the roof of the building.

The launch event will also be an opportunity for those attending to see a specially designed projection mapping installation which includes images of Pwllheli's sailing heritage, past and present, contributed by the community.

The dramatic artwork has been funded by the Arts Council for Wales and promises to be an eye-catching addition to the £8.9 million National Sailing Academy and Events Centre, which has been built with support from the European Regional Development Fund through the Welsh Government and Gwynedd Council.
